Systematic Curriculum Delivery from Prep to Year 6

- 100% of year 3 and year 5 students achieving at or above National Minimum Standard (NMS) in reading for the National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN).
- 100% of all students demonstrating continuing gains, through monitored data in reading.

Embedding Effective Pedagogical Practices

- 100% of staff having current and relative Developing Performance Plans (DPP) that are reviewed regularly.
- Whole school reading plan reviewed and embedded in both classrooms.
- Departmental Speech Language Pathologist to work with classroom teachers to create and embed support programs for speech, language and literacy for students.
- 100% of staff involved in Watching Others Work (WOW) cycle.

Systematic Data Analysis and Discussion

- 100% of students A-E and diagnostic data is collected and evident on One School mark books
- 100% of parents and students attending Parent/Teacher interviews each semester to discuss learning, goals and achievements.

Our initiatives include

- Use Early Start and the P-10 Literacy Continuum to monitor students' progress in literacy, particularly reading.
- Develop and implement a plan for the systematic collection of a range of student data including; A-E assessment data and diagnostic testing.
- All teaching staff and teacher aides promote and engage in a range of evidence-based teaching strategies, particularly the Sheena Cameron reading strategies.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- School purchase Speech Language Pathologist for one day per week to access services to monitor student progress and targeted intervention/support for speech, language and literacy.
- Collaboratively refine and plan a Whole School Reading Program with teachers and Speech Language Pathologist.
- Purchase resources and professional development to support the implementation of a Whole School Reading Plan.
